

INTERVIEWER: Read each question to participant. Tell them to rate how characteristic the statement is of them. Their answers should be based on the 7-point Likert scale from extremely uncharacteristic to extremely characteristic. Say, "On a scale from 1 to 7, 1 being extremely uncharacteristic and 7 being extremely characteristic, how true is this statement of you."
