

Children's Memory Scale (CMS)

This measure provides a comprehensive assessment of learning and memory systems in children and adolescents ages 5 through 16 years. It is an individually administered assessment and is a parallel version of the WMS, which is commonly used for adults. The primary indexes for memory dimensions assessed include verbal immediate, verbal delayed, visual immediate, visual delayed, general memory, delayed recognition, learning, attention, and concentration.
