

Coopersmith Self Esteem Inventory (CSEI)

This is a questionnaire designed to assess feelings of self-worth manifested in attitudes and expressions. It is normed for use in children from age eight to fifteen, but has also been adapted for reliable use in adult populations. It includes personal belief statements such as whether they usually expect success or failure, and how they typically react to failure. The questions are designed in a way that the individual must decide whether each statement listed is like or unlike them.
