

Family Assessment Device (FAD)

This questionnaire is designed to assess attitudes and beliefs on family functioning through a variety of statements about families. Respondents are to rank how accurately or inaccurately each item pertains to their own family. Each answer is inversely ranked on a 3-point scale ranging from “strongly agree” to “strongly disagree”. This measure is comprised of seven scales: Problem Solving, Communication, Family Roles, Affective Responsiveness, Affective Involvement, Behavior Control and General Functioning.
