

**Schedule for Affective Disorders and Schizophrenia-Present and Lifetime Version
(SADS-PL)**

This is a semi-structured interview used to assess psychiatric history in adults. It is intended for use only by trained interviewers. It is used to identify current and past episodes of major psychiatric disorders, based on DSM-IV established criteria.*
