

The Wechsler Adult Intelligence Scale – Fourth Edition (WAIS-IV): Coding subtest *only*

In the coding subtest, using a key provided, adult examinees are instructed to copy symbols paired with numbers within a specified time limit. This subtest is considered a core Processing Speed subtest. In addition to processing speed, this subtest also measures one's short-term memory, learning ability, visual perception, visual-motor coordination, visual scanning ability, cognitive flexibility, attention, and motivation. It is also said to involve visual and sequential processing.
