

WECHSLER MEMORY SCALE-THIRD EDITION (WMS-III)



These scales provide primary indices for auditory immediate, visual immediate, immediate memory, auditory delayed, visual delayed, auditory recognition delayed, general memory, and working memory. Norms include scores in the expanded age ranges for adults, from 74 through 89 years of age. This third edition has extended floors, and subtest content has been revised to index more accurately domain-specific memory processes. Scores correlate strongly with scores on the *Children's Memory Scale*, allowing assessment of the same memory processes across the lifespan.
