

ZUCKERMAN-KUHLMAN SENSATION SEEKING SCALE

This scale is the impulsive, sensation seeking dimension of the Zuckerman-Kuhlman Personality Questionnaire Version III-R (ZKPQ-III-R). This scale includes 19 true/false items reliably measuring the construct of sensation seeking. This scale measures socialization, psychoticism, impulsivity, and sensation-seeking. The impulsivity items assess planning vs. acting without thinking. The sensation seeking items assess excitement and thrill-seeking behaviors for novelty and variety, and unpredictable situations and friends.
